- 1 must:** It is used to express a strong rule, an important obligation, or something you feel is necessary.
- 2 have to:** It is used to express something that is necessary because of rules—and when there is no other choice.
- 3 mustn't:** It is used to express something is not allowed.
- 4 should:** It is used to advise someone or express a good idea.
- 5 don't/doesn't have to:** It is used to express that something is not necessary.

Examples:

- ◆ You **must** follow the rules of the team. ◆ You **have to** come early tomorrow.
- ◆ You **mustn't** shout at hospitals. ◆ He **doesn't have to** sleep early. It's a holiday.
- ◆ You **should** do exercises regularly.
