2 Defining and non-defining relative clauses

Type	Purpose	Example
Defining (D)	Provide essential information to identify the person, place, time, or thing. No commas are used.	The teacher who teaches math is very strict.
Non-defining (ND)	Provide extra, non-essential information. Commas are used to separate the clauses.	My teacher, who is very kind , helped me with my homework.

- ▶ Sequencers are words like “**First**”, “**Next**”, “**Then**”, and “**Finally**” that show the order of steps or events.

- ◆ **How:** Manner/Method

2 Explaining a point of view

- ◆ Saying why you prefer one thing to another.
- ◆ Making a simple comparison.
- ◆ Agreeing with something.
- ◆ Asking for more details or explaining that you do not think the same.

Listening skills

Listening for numbers

- ▶ Check if a question is asking you for a number or a year.
- ◆ Listen carefully to large numbers. For example, for 800, people say “eight hundred”.
- ◆ Also, listen carefully to years. For example, for 1930, people say “nineteen thirty”, and for 2020 they say “twenty twenty”.
