After Makkah, he travelled through Turkey, Russia, and India, where he worked for a king for seven years. In 1342, the king sent him to the most powerful king in the world, the king of China,

but his boat sank while it was sailing through a storm. However, Ibn Battuta survived, and in 1344, he reached China and traveled to the capital city, Beijing. He spent several years in China before he traveled home, passing through Damascus, Cairo and Spain. During the last few years of his life, he wrote a book about his travels called "Travels in Asia and Africa". Ibn Battuta died in 1368.
