a train (n.)		- A long vehicle that moves on tracks and carries people or things from one place to another. <b>Example:</b> We go to the city by a train.

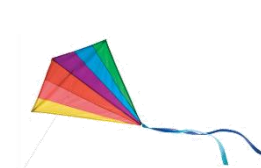

<b>Do</b>	you	<b>want</b>	a bike?	Yes, I <b>do</b> .	
				No, I <b>don't</b> . I <b>want</b> a train.	
<b>Does</b>	he/she			Yes, he <b>does</b> .	
				No, she <b>doesn't</b> . She <b>wants</b> a train.	
				<i>don't = do not</i>	
				<i>doesn't = does not</i>	

To ask a question: **Do** you + want ...? or **Does** he/she + want ...?

#### 1. With I / You / We / They

- We use **want** (no "s").  
👉 Example:
- I want a ball.
- You want a kite.
- They want a bike.

#### 2. With He / She / It

- We add **-s** → **wants**.  
👉 Example:
- He wants a car.
- She wants a puppet.
- It wants water.



- If the subject is **he / she / it** → add **s** to *want* (wants).
- If the subject is **I / you / we / they** → just use *want*.
