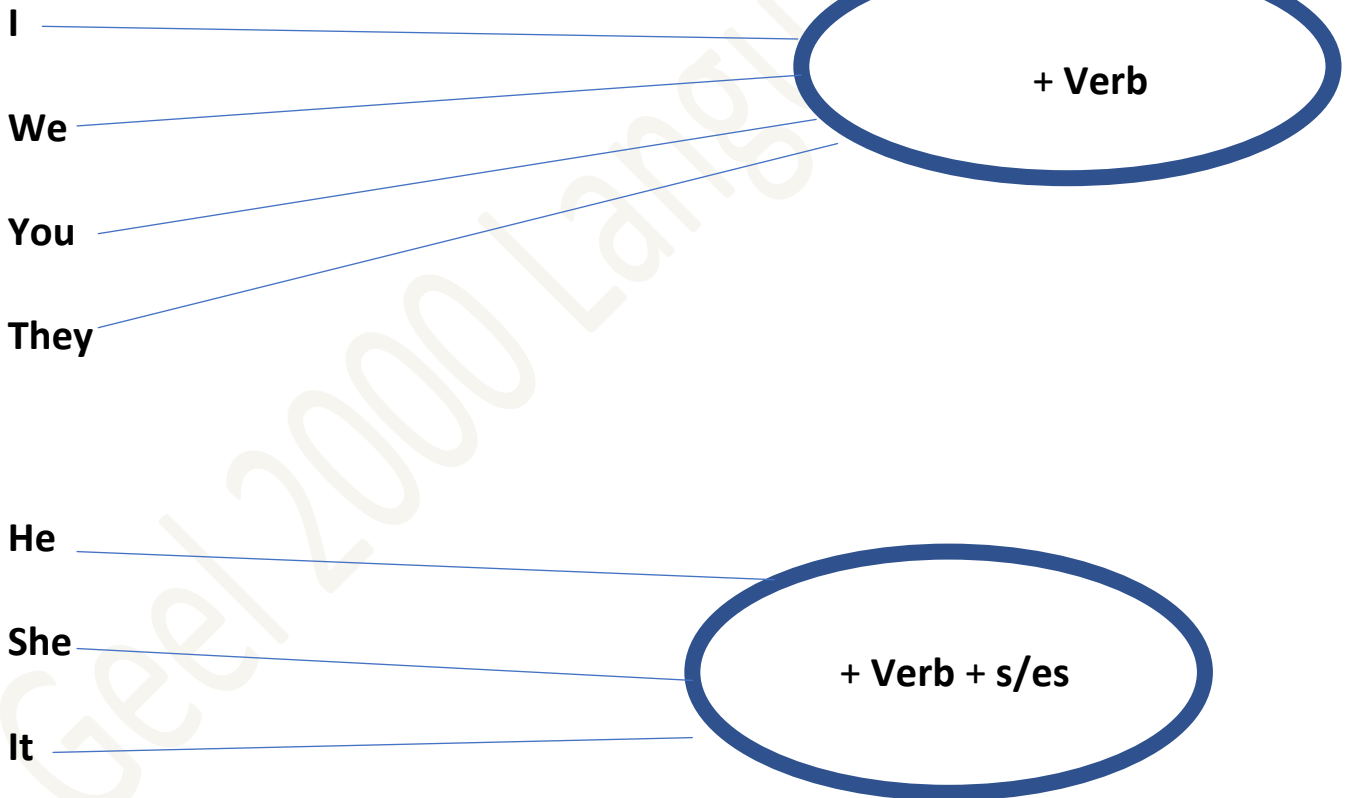
Present Simple Tense

Ex: I go to school every week.

Ahmed sleeps at 8 o'clock every day.

We always have lunch at 1 o'clock.

Ex:eat eating study studying

-When the verb ends in e, we delete the e and put -ing.

Ex:have having dance dancing

-When the verb ends in a consonant and before that there is a vowel (a,e,i,o,u) then we double the final consonant and add ing.-

Ex:get getting put putting
