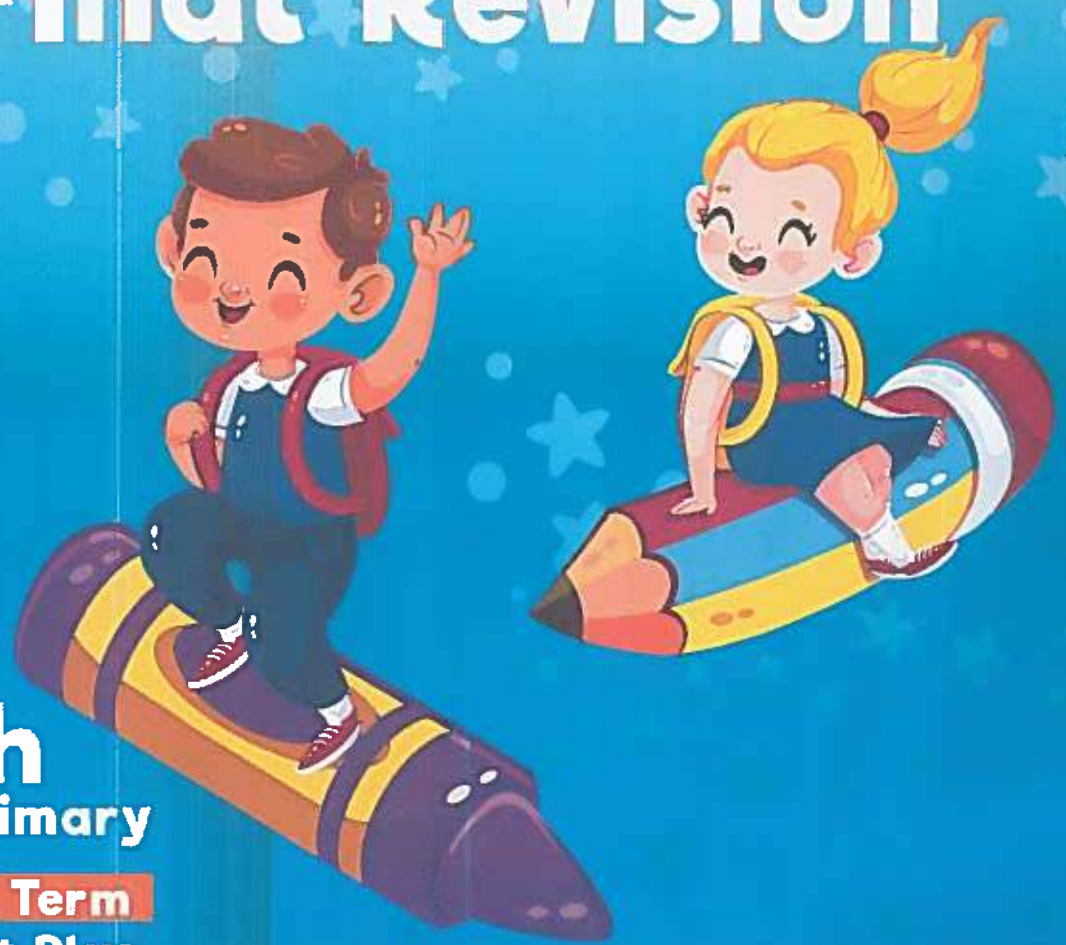

Late (adjective) → Late (adverb)

e.g. - He arrived late.

Some adverbs are irregular or have different forms:

Good (adjective) → Well (adverb)

e.g. - She sings well.

Hard (adjective) → Hard (adverb)

e.g. - He works hard.

Most adverbs are formed by adding (-ily) to the adjectives.
